Message from the Principal

Welcome to the new academic year and the first Chelsea Academy Update. To those students and staff who are joining us for the first time, I'd like to extend a special welcome to our Academy community. We've already had a busy couple of weeks.

Summer examination results

The Academy has produced yet another excellent set of results in GCSE and A level exams this summer. Of note were our Year 11 students who made significant progress across the board. The percentage of students achieving a good pass in English and Maths (i.e a C or higher) was 72%, compared to 66% the previous year. Our A level results were just as good with a figure of 51% achieving A* - B grades in their subject areas, with two students going on to Oxford University and over 95% of Year 13 students going on to study at University including many Russell Group institutions. Congratulations to all our students who are moving on to the next stage in their education and a huge thank you to all staff for their hard work.

As always we have high expectations of all our students and your support in ensuring that students meet our standards for behaviour, punctuality, attendance and uniform is greatly appreciated. As always, more information about expectations in all these areas can be found on the Academy website.

Our student will offer guided tours for the prospective parents and students.


There is no need to book – please just come along at any time between 6pm and 8.30 pm and see what Chelsea Academy has to offer your child.

The Chinese exam results are out!



On Saturday 16th July thirteen Year 9 Chelsea Academy students sat their HSK level 1 Chinese Mandarin qualification test at SOAS university. The Chinese Proficiency Test is China's only standardized test of Standard Chinese language proficiency for non-native speakers. It is the most recognised Mandarin Chinese qualification worldwide. Students worked very hard throughout the enrichment course and clearly also revised in their own time for the exam. When we met at school to make our way to SOAS students had vocabulary lists and carried on revising and supporting each other! They represented The Academy brilliantly so it was with delight that we received the news that 12/13 students passed and obtained their qualification! Congratulations! 非常好!


