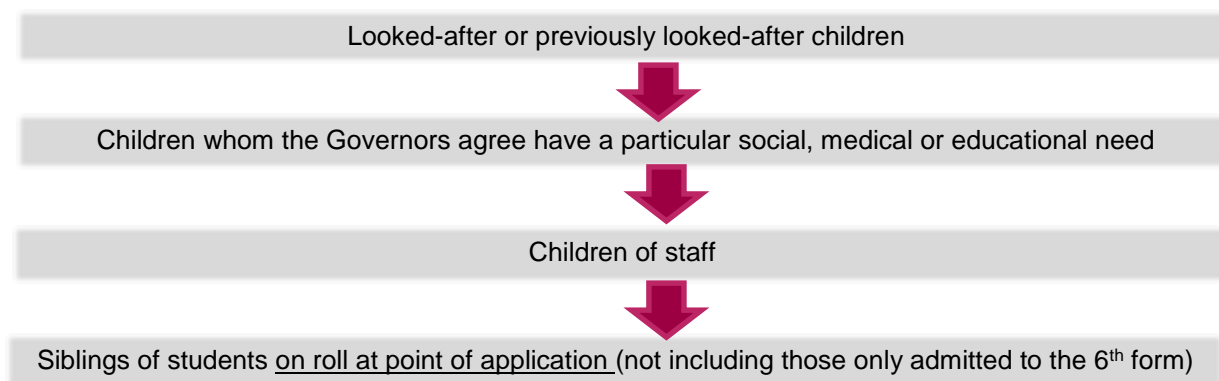


How we allocate in-year admissions from waiting lists

We have 180 places in each year. If a vacancy occurs, we allocate in this order:



Then:

Foundation (Church) places	Community places
<p>F1 Children who regularly attend² a C of E Church in the Deaneries of Kensington, Chelsea, Hammersmith and Fulham or Westminster <u>AND</u> who last attended a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school)</p>	<p>Places are allocated in order of distance from home address to the Academy, measured in a straight line using the RBKC computerised measuring service</p>
<p>F2 Children who regularly attend² other Christian churches or chapels³ <u>AND</u> who last attended a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school)</p>	
<p>F3 Children who regularly attend² a Christian church or chapel³ in the Deaneries of Kensington, Chelsea, Hammersmith and Fulham or Westminster</p>	
<p>F4 Children who last attended a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school)</p> <p>If any category is oversubscribed places are allocated at random using an independently-supervised draw.</p>	

² Regular attendance at church must have been for at least one year, on at least two occasions per month. The only exception will be families who have moved into the area within the previous year and can provide a Vicar's/Minister's letter to confirm that they attended a church regularly in the place where they used to live.

³ Christian churches or chapels must be members of Churches Together in Britain and Ireland or of the Evangelical Alliance or Afro-Caribbean Evangelical Alliance
