Notification of collapse of Year 10 Bubble

I am writing to notify you that over the weekend we had additional confirmed cases of coronavirus in Year 10. Therefore due to an increase in the number of confirmed positive cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) within the year group, and following advice from the Department of Education and RBKC, we have regretfully made the decision to collapse the Year 10 bubble.

This will be in place until the end of Monday 30th November 2020.

Students will continue with their remote learning, and should be logged in and ready to complete their learning during usual academy hours. Your child will continue to access lessons through google classroom. Lessons will be live or with a live element, however there are a small number of staff who are unwell with the virus and therefore their lessons will take the form of tasks and assignments set on google classroom.

You may have received a phone call and/or email from the Academy to notify you that your child has been in close contact with one of the affected individuals and must therefore self-isolate. This advice still applies, and if you have received a call or email your family must follow the instructions set out in the letter.

It is with great regret that we have had to make this decision, and we have not taken it lightly. I am confident in staff and students' ability to deliver and receive high quality lessons whilst at home, and trust our students to maintain their focus whilst we move through this unprecedented stage in their education. If you have any concerns about your child's engagement or wellbeing during this time, please do speak to someone in the Pastoral team, or your child's class teacher or learning coach (all staff emails are on our website).
