Edulink will give you information about your child's timetable, achievements, behaviour points, attendance.

Edulink

Parents can access the information management admin system that we use here at Chelsea Academy. It allows parents to keep their contact details and consents up to date and it allows us to easily communicate with parents about attendance data, achievement and behaviour data.

www.gcsepod.com	Once on the GCSEPOD website, click 'log in with Google' and if you are logged into the CALC, it will log you straight in. If it takes you to a login screen, simply use the username and password you use for the CALC and your Google products.	No	Yes	As with the CALC username and passwords, all teachers have access to reset your CALC passwords and therefore your GCSEPOD passwords. They can also share your username with you. Please ask your learning coach to reset your password on the system and your password will become: <i>password</i> .
