**Re: Green For Grenfell 2021**

As you may be aware, next week marks four years since the tragedy of Grenfell Tower. Chelsea Academy is once again asking all students and staff to wear green on **Friday 11th June 2021** in support of survivors and families bereaved by the fire, who continue to work together for the community and campaign for safer homes, justice and change.

Students are invited to wear non uniform on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2021, **as long as they are wearing predominantly green clothes.** There will be no compulsory donation for dressing in green on this occasion, as the aim is to raise awareness rather than to fundraise.

Should your child choose to dress in their own (predominantly green) clothes, please ensure that they do not wear anything inappropriate or which might offend, for example: strapped vest tops, items which show bare midriffs or t-shirts bearing offensive slogans. We would, of course, encourage them to wear official 'Green for Grenfell' merchandise as this will help raise additional awareness of the campaign.

Students should also be reminded that Friday is a normal day of lessons and that they **MUST** bring their planner, together with an Academy bag containing the usual correct books and equipment/ PE Kit if applicable.

Thank you for your support with this event, we hope that Friday will prove to be a thought provoking and reflective day that continues to raise understanding of the ongoing issues surrounding the Grenfell tragedy.
