

**Sports Day: The Chelsea Academy Games 2021**

Dear Parent/Carer,

**On Monday 21st June 2021** we will be holding our annual Chelsea Academy Games (Sports Day) at Battersea Park's Millennium Stadium. As well as the regular athletics activities taking place inside the stadium, every student will be competing in their House in a number of different activities, including Rounders, Handball, Volleyball, Cricket and Tug of War throughout the day in the park. We are delighted that we can run this event after the disruption of the past year.

Your child will be off-site for the whole day on Monday 21st June. It is important that students arrive promptly to the Academy at 8:35am in full Chelsea Academy PE kit. If they arrive without full kit, they will be given a replacement or sent home to change. If they are entitled to free school meals the Academy will provide them with a packed lunch. However, **if you pay for school meals then please provide a packed lunch for your child on this day.** It is likely to be a warm day so please ensure students have sun cream, plenty of water and a jacket in case it rains. Should the weather be too wet then lessons will take place as normal.

Unfortunately, due to space restrictions, we cannot accommodate parents at this event. We will be taking a number of videos and photos that we will make available on the Academy website and social media. Following the Chelsea Academy Games, students will **be dismissed from the park at 3:20pm** and will make their own way home from the park. Please note that after 3.20pm Academy staff do not have responsibility for your child but there will be members of staff returning to the Academy who can escort your child back to the Academy.
