As a member of Chelsea Academy Sixth Form you will:

- Attend weekly lectures to hear from notable guests including barristers, CEOs and university lecturers.
- Receive bespoke support to plan your application to university, degree apprenticeships or a gap year.
- Have the opportunity to apply for a place on the Access Project.
- Engage in at least three weeks of work based learning and summer school activities during the summer of Y12.

What do Chelsea Academy students do after their A levels?

The majority of our students go to university, with some studying internationally. Students who are interested in alternatives to university are supported to apply for degree apprenticeships and school leaver programmes.

We talk a lot about university choice but not all school leavers choose to go straight to university. You can talk to us about extended work experience and taking a Gap Year. Find out more about Apprenticeships and Sponsored Degrees as an increasingly popular alternative route into professional training.

Our Careers Service remains open to Chelsea Academy students beyond graduation. As an alumni, you can make an application to UCAS through us after a gap year.
