

How we allocate in-year admissions from waiting lists

We have 180 places in each year. If a vacancy occurs, we allocate in this order:

Children whom the Governors agree have a particular social, medical or educational need

Children of staff

Siblings¹ of students on roll at point of application (not including those only admitted to the 6th form)

Then:

Foundation (Church) places

<u>F1</u> Children who regularly attend² a C of E Church in the Deaneries of Kensington, Chelsea, Hammersmith and Fulham or Westminster <u>AND</u> who last attended a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school)



<u>F2</u> Children who regularly attend² other Christian churches or chapels³ <u>AND</u> who last attended a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school)



<u>F3</u> Children who regularly attend² a Christian church or chapel³ in the Deaneries of Kensington, Chelsea, Hammersmith and Fulham or Westminster ⁴



<u>F4</u> Children who last attended a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school)

If any category is oversubscribed places are allocated at random using an independently-supervised draw.

Community places

Places are allocated in order of distance from home address to the Academy, measured in a straight line using the RBKC computerised measuring service

¹ Includes half-siblings, adopted siblings and step-siblings provided that they live as siblings at the same address as the applicant.

² Regular attendance at church must have been for at least one year within the past 3 years, on at least two occasions per month. This includes attendance at virtual or online services. In the event that during this period the church or relevant place of worship, has been closed for public worship and has not provided alternative premises for that worship, the requirements of these admissions arrangements in relation to attendance will only apply to the period when the church or alternative premises have been available for public worship.

³ Christian churches or chapels must be members of Churches Together in Britain and Ireland or of the Evangelical Alliance or of the Orthodox or Oriental Orthodox family of churches
