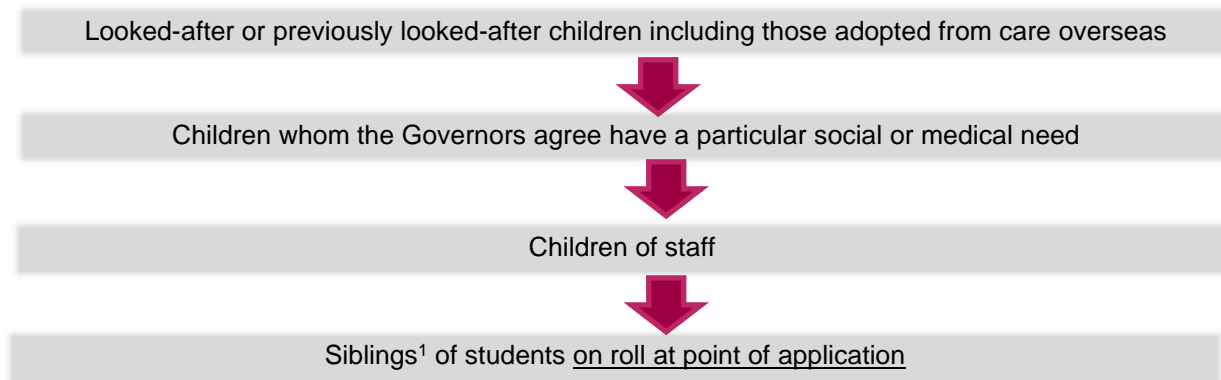


How we allocate in-year admissions from waiting lists

We have 180 places in each year. If a vacancy occurs, after the admission of those students with an EHCP naming Chelsea Academy we will allocate in this order:



Then:

Foundation (Church) places	Community places
<p>F1 Children who regularly attend² a Christian church or ^{chape}l³ in the Deaneries of Kensington, Chelsea, Hammersmith and Fulham or Westminster <u>AND</u> who last attended a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder)</p>	<p>Places are allocated in order of distance from home address to the Academy, measured in a straight line using the RBKC computerised measuring service</p>
<p>F2 Children who regularly attend² a Christian church or chapel³ in the Deaneries of Kensington, Chelsea, Hammersmith and Fulham or Westminster⁴</p>	
<p>F3 Children who last attended a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school)</p>	
<p>If any category is oversubscribed places within that category are allocated in order of distance from home address to the Academy, measured in a straight line using the RBKC computerised measuring service</p>	

¹ Includes half-siblings, adopted siblings and step-siblings who live as siblings at the same address as the applicant.

² Regular attendance at church must have been for at least one year in the past 3 years, at least twice per month. This includes attendance at virtual or online services. If during this period the place of worship has been closed for public worship and has not provided alternative premises, the requirements will only apply to the period when the church has been available for public worship.

³ Christian churches or chapels must be members of Churches Together in Britain and Ireland or of the Evangelical Alliance or of the Orthodox or Oriental Orthodox family of churches
