

## **PRIORITY FOR YEAR 7 PLACES SEPT 2023**

We have 180 places and after the admission of those students with an EHCP naming Chelsea Academy we will allocate in this order:

Looked-after or previously looked-after children including those adopted from care overseas



Children whom the Governors agree have a particular social or medical need



Children of staff



Siblings<sup>1</sup> of students on roll on 31st Oct 2022 (closing date for applications)

## Then any remaining places are offered in this order:

## 50% as Foundation (Church) places

<u>F1</u> Children who regularly attend<sup>2</sup> a Christian church or chapel<sup>3</sup> <u>AND</u> on the closing date for applications are attending a foundation feeder primary school. These are:

Christ Church CE Primary SW3 Holy Trinity CE Primary SW1

St Barnabas and St Philip's CE Primary W8

St Clement and St James CE Primary W11

St Cuthbert with St Matthias CE Primary SW5

St Mary Abbots CE Primary W8

St Thomas' CE Primary W10



<u>F2</u> Children who regularly attend<sup>2</sup> a Christian church or chapel<sup>3</sup> in the Deaneries of Kensington, Chelsea, Hammersmith and Fulham or Westminster<sup>4</sup>



<u>F3</u> Children who on the closing date for applications are attending a foundation feeder primary school (see list in F1).

## 50% as Community (Open) places

<u>C1</u> Children who on the closing date for applications are attending a community feeder primary school.

These are:

Ashburnham Primary SW10 Park Walk Primary SW10 Bousfield Primary SW5 Marlborough Primary SW3



<u>C2</u> Children who do not attend a community feeder primary school

In March 2022 we offered places to:

- all applicants in F1 and F2 and some applicants in F3
- applicants in C1 up to a distance of 1.22 miles
- no applicants in C2

By September 2022 we had offered to all applicants in F3 and C1 and applicants in C2 up to a distance of 0.64 miles

If any category is oversubscribed places are allocated in order of distance from home to the Academy, measured in a straight line using the RBKC computerised measuring service

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Regular attendance at church must have been for at least one year in the past 3 years, at least twice per month. This includes attendance at virtual or online services. If during this period the place of worship has been closed for public worship and has not provided alternative premises, the requirements will only apply to the period when the church has been available for public worship.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Christian churches or chapels must be members of Churches Together in Britain and Ireland or of the Evangelical Alliance or of the Orthodox or Oriental Orthodox family of churches
