Entrance Requirements and next steps

- Students need to get a Grade 5 in English Language or Literature and a Grade 5 in Maths.
- They then need to meet the entrance criteria for three of four subjects you wish to study.
- Application is via an online form on our website.





Application timeline

- 9th November open evening
- 31st January deadline for applications to Chelsea Academy Sixth Form - applications online

- 28th February you will know if you have a conditional offer by this date
- 22nd August GCSE results day AND Sixth Form enrollment day from 9am





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
