We are very pleased to offer the opportunity for your child to learn, or continue learning an instrument at Chelsea Academy. Music is an important aspect of Academy life and we encourage every student to take the opportunity to continue, or start instrumental and / or vocal tuition with our visiting teachers.

These exceptional musicians, along with other professional musicians and teachers, will be offering our students tuition on a wide range of instruments. We are able to offer 10 lessons per term (30 minutes long). These lessons will be on the same day each week, but on a rotational timing basis during the school day. It may be possible to hire instruments on a termly basis, or to purchase them via the Academy or a number of national schemes. Chelsea Academy is committed to providing the greatest opportunities for all our students and we have been able to negotiate competitive fees from our instrumental and vocal teachers, to encourage all our students to take part if they wish. Payment of fees must be made within two weeks of each full term, to the Academy. Fees for the year will be put on ParentPay for the Academic year. Your child will continue to have lessons each year unless you provide a terms notice by email to me.

To apply for lessons, please complete the attached form and return it to the Academy, either via reception or to your child's learning coach. Please submit a separate form for each individual instrument/voice. Students will be placed on a waiting list and notified in writing to confirm their place and lesson times. A timetable will be displayed in the Music Curriculum Area at least three days before the lesson. The student is responsible for checking this timetable.

Your child will continue to have lessons each academic year unless notice is given or payment has not been received. You do not need to reapply each year.

Parents / carers must provide **A TERM'S WRITTEN NOTICE** if they wish lessons to cease, and payment will continue until the end of that period, as teachers are paid for each term's tuition.
