Subject	English	Maths	Subject specific requirements
Art	5	4	Grade 6 in GCSE Art and Design, or a grade 6 in a related DT subject such as Graphic Products, Textiles or Resistant Materials, or a Distinction in BTEC First Diploma in Art and Design.
Biology	5	5	Grade 7-7 in GCSE Combined Science Double Award, or a grade 7 in GCSE Biology plus another grade 7 in GCSE Chemistry or Physics.
Business Studies	6	5	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or English Literature is required, and a GCSE in Business Studies would be an advantage but is not essential
Chemistry	4	6	Grade 7-7 in Combined Science Double Award GCSE, or a grade 7 in GCSE Chemistry plus another grade 7 in GCSE Biology or Physics, plus a grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics.
Computer Science	4	7	Grade 7 in GCSE Computer Science, and a grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics.
Design Technology	5	5	A grade 5 in GCSE English Language or English Literature, grade 5 in GCSE Mathematics and grade 6 in GCSE Design and Technology.
Drama	6	4	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or English Literature is required, and a GCSE in Drama would be an advantage but is not essential.
Economics	6	6	Grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics, and a grade 6 in GCSE English Language or English Literature is required, plus grade 6 in GCSE Economics and/or Business Studies if taken at GCSE.
English Language and Literature	6 and 6	4	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language and a grade 6 in GCSE English Literature.
English Literature	7 and 6	4	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language and a grade 7 in GCSE English Literature, or a grade 7 in GCSE English Language and a grade 6 in GCSE English Literature.
Film Studies	6	4	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or English Literature, grade 6 in GCSE Film Studies and/or Media Studies if taken at GCSE.
French	6	4	Grade 7 in GCSE French is required along with a grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or Literature.
Geography	5	5	Grade 6 in GCSE Geography, and a grade 6-6 in GCSE Combined Science Dual Award or two grade 6 from any two GCSE separate science subjects.
Government & Politics	6	4	Grade 6 in English Language or English Literature and a grade 6 in a humanities subject, such as Citizenship, History, Geography or RE.

History	6	4	Grade 6 in History and grade 6 in English Language or English Literature.
Maths	4	7	Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics
Maths - Further Maths	4	9*	Grade 9 in GCSE Mathematics * or Grade 8 in GCSE Mathematics and Grade 7 in GCSE Further Mathematics/Additional Maths. Must start Year 12 with Further Maths as a fourth A level.
Media Studies	6	4	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or English Literature, grade 6 in GCSE Film Studies and/or Media Studies if taken at GCSE.
Physics	4	7	Grade 7-7 in GCSE Combined Science Double Award, or 7 in GCSE Physics plus another grade 7 in GCSE Biology or Physics, and a grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics. Students must also choose to study Maths at A level.
Psychology	5	6	Grade 6-6 in GCSE Combined Science, or two grade 6 in any two separate science GCSE, or a grade 6 in GCSE Psychology
Religion, Philosophy & Ethics	6	4	Grade 6 in English Language or English Literature is required, and a grade 6 in RE or another humanities subject, such as Citizenship, History or Geography.
Sociology	6	4	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or English Literature and a grade 6 in a GCSE humanities subject, such as Citizenship, History, Geography or RE.
Spanish	6	4	Grade 7 in GCSE Spanish is required along with a grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or Literature.
