In the event that during this period the church or relevant place of worship, has been closed for public worship and has not provided alternative premises for that worship, the requirements of these admissions arrangements in relation to attendance will only apply to the period when the church or alternative premises have been available for public worship. Similarly, those who have recently moved to the area and who worshipped previously in a different area will be asked to supply a reference from that church so that the 1 year period is confirmed.


