### **Festive events next week**

Next week is our last of the term before the Christmas holidays and as you hopefully are aware, we have some Christmas fun planned for students. There will be celebration assemblies running throughout the week recognising students' achievements this term. Students in Years 7 - 10 will also have the opportunity to purchase a Christmas lunch (dates in the table below). This will be the only lunch on offer for the year group that day (although they may of course bring their own lunch). Students in different year groups who are NOT having their Christmas lunch will be able to choose options from the Grab and Go selection. Students who receive free school meals will receive a Christmas lunch as usual. Students may also choose to wear a Christmas jumper or similar festive item on their Christmas lunch day. However with the exception of the jumper it is otherwise normal Academy uniform.

### **Year 11 Mock results and Progress evening**

Year 11 have had an excellent Autumn term in which we have been really impressed by their focus and resilience. Last week, their mock exams began in which students sit assessments in all of their subjects in the exam hall. Whilst this can be daunting, it does give students the experience of this more formal setting which makes the summer GCSEs less stressful.

The year group will receive their results shortly before Progress Evening in January during a special assembly. That Progress Evening, on 15th January 2026, will allow you and your young person to discuss next steps in order to achieve the best set of GCSE results possible.

### **Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme**

This Christmas there are over 60 organisations across Westminster and Kensington & Chelsea offering free activities and free, healthy meals to children and young people aged 4-16 years, who are in receipt of benefits-related Free School Meals. Activities are available for an average of 4 hours per day and include sports camps, music, dance, arts & crafts, adventure play, youth clubs, offsite trips and activities for those with special educational needs and disabilities. ### Financial advice and support for RBKC residents

The Kensington and Chelsea Foundation has a fund called Winter Warmth that pays fuel bills for residents in need and another called Cash First, which issues fairly modest amounts of cash to people in financial crisis. You will get specialist advice and support, which can help families manage debt/finance or address housing issues amongst other things. This is often a really challenging time of year in terms of finances and there is help available.

The last date of dispatch for online orders will be Tuesday 16th December. This does not affect their 30 day returns policy and will be extended for any customers that have ordered in the last 14 days.

A reminder that the Academy is closed on **Monday 5th January** to students and will reopen to students on Tuesday 6th January for the start of the Spring Term. Next week will see the second Anchor and Flourish of the year being sent to you, so keep an eye out for that.
