Dear parents and carers,

Year 13, 11 and 10 mock exams

The Year 13 mock exams begin immediately following the half term break on Tuesday 24th February and run until Monday 9th March. Year 11 students will also sit a mock exam for Science, Maths and English in the exam hall, while Year 10 will sit their GCSE RE mock exam.

Year 12 Progress evening (online)

Our Year 12 Progress evening will be held on Thursday 5th March between 4.00 - 7.30pm. The Parents Evening Booking System is now open for parents/ carers to book their virtual appointments. This is the opportunity for you to speak with subject teachers as your Y12 student has now really settled into their courses. As staff will be working late to support this event, students will once again start their day a little later the next morning - Friday 6th March. We will open for breakfast at 9:00am, and lessons will start with Period 2 at 9:30am. No student can be on site before 9am. This is in place of an earlier finish on Thursday 5th March.

Year 7 Spiritual Retreats

Our new Chaplain Anita Rolls will be leading the upcoming Year 7 Spiritual Retreat days in March. We delayed these from the autumn so we could wait until Anita had joined us. The day will involve your child's Coaching Group visiting St. Luke's Church in Redcliffe Gardens, Earls Court. Students will be taking part in team building and reflective activities to help them get to know themselves, their peers and our staff better.
